Enjoy easy walking to and from cafes, shops and village accommodation.

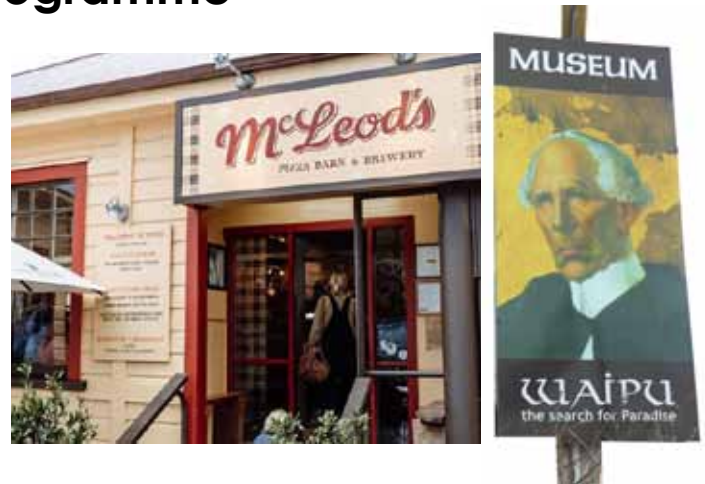


Partners' Programme
