General information

The fee is \$150.00 per student which covers the accommodation from Friday 13th checking out Sunday 15th January, on a shared twin arrangement, all meals from morning tea on the 13th January to lunch 15th January, and all course materials. This Institute is subsidised by Lions international and Lions Clubs of New Zealand. All transport and extra costs are at your own cost.

For anyone wanting to arrive a day earlier the accommodation would be at your own cost, and for anyone not wanting to share a room there is an option of a Massey University campus room. We will however provide transport from these rooms to the seminar rooms free of charge (It is a distance of around 500 metres within the Massey university grounds.)

Single accommodation an extra \$40.00 per night

Thursday night accommodation \$120.00

The payments will be invoiced to the participant from the National office, if a club or district has agreed to pay for this they will need to send it on.

Expectations

There are some pre assignments that need to be completed prior to attending that will be sent to you once your place on this Institute has been confirmed.

All participants are expected to attend all sessions starting at 10am on Friday 13th January until 3.00pm on Sunday 15th January in order to graduate. This means being ready to go at 10am and ensuring that pre-flight check in is not before 3.45pm.

All participants are expected to stay onsite and participate in all aspects of the weekend including meals.

All participants are encouraged to bring their own devices if possible, it is not an issue if you cannot.

All accommodation bookings are done by us, you **do not** need to contact the facility **all** correspondence should come through us.

Please note that the venue is at the back of Massey University and away from Palmerston North City. Given the University is closed when we are there, there will be no close facilities or shops. Please bring all you need with you.
