Internet banking info.

Internet Banking information for Club's Treasurers for payment of dues.

As we all know cheques are going to be obsolete from 1st July 2021.

Your club must visit your bank to make arrangements for setting up internet banking if you have not already done so. They will advise you how to go about this. If there are two signatures required then they will help you with codes etc that are needed to do the banking. Every bank will be different so you do need to visit and not just take advice from friends.

Once you are registered for internet banking you will need to set up the payee's details for your club to pay dues. Note that you need two accounts. Although one account is for International dues, the account is a NZ-based account, so you shouldn't have any issues setting it up with your bank.

- Lions District 202D Admin 03-0791-0232608-000 a. This account is used for your district dues, president's dinner, anything to do with running the club. When you make a payment make sure that you include your Club name in the "Reference" section of the payment.
- 2. Lions Club International LCI 03-0502-0081103-00
 - a. This account is the one for your International dues. Your club will receive the statement via internet on 'MyLion' then into 'MyLCI'. The statement is due at the end of July and end of January of each year. If you have trouble getting into MyLion, please contact Steve Barr on 0274499648 or by email at sbarr@inspire.net.nz or myself at 202d.treasurer@lionsclubs.org.nz and we can try and help. A common issue is that birthdates need to be entered in the American format of mm-dd-yyyy rather than our usual format dd-mm-yyyy.
 - b. When you deposit into LCI please put your club number reference e.g.12345. If you don't have this, send me an email and I can give it to you. It is on your LCI statement. If you have trouble with the statement, I can send one.
 - c. PLEASE DO NOT DEPOSIT DISTRICT 202D DUES INTO THIS ACCOUNT. It is near impossible to get it returned from America.
 - d. Remember to add a few more dollars to the payment to cover exchange rates.


