## MD202 – PAT RYAN AWARD Youth Activity

## **PURPOSE:**

- 1. To encourage club participation in youth activities.
- 2. Youth are defined as children and/or young people aged up to 19 years.
- 3. To stimulate friendly rivalry between clubs and districts by implementing exciting and adventurous youth programmes.
- 4. To enable worthy youth activities to be recorded and made available for use by other clubs.

## **RULES:**

- 1. Please submit the generic MD202 Award entry form with your entry.
- 2. The winning entry submitted by each District should be based on one youth activity (not an accumulation of youth activities).
- 3. In an email of up to 500 words describe the club's youth activity providing evidence that demonstrates how the criteria list below has been met.
- 4. Submit additional information and evidence such as press/ publicity information, letters of thanks, reports and photos.

## CRITERIA:

1. Number of youth involved	10 points
<ol> <li>Benefit to the participants and the community e.g. leadership, self confidence</li> </ol>	20 points
3. Percentage of club members involved	10 points
<ol> <li>Initiative and enterprise</li> <li>e.g. identification, planning &amp; delivery of activity</li> </ol>	10 points
