- 2. In an email of up to 500 words, describe how the club has reached the conclusion of a project or activity in the preceding fiscal year that demonstrates service to the community.
- 3. Provide evidence that demonstrates how the criteria list below has been met including how the project / service was identified and planned.
- 4. Provide additional information and evidence such as press/ publicity information, letters of congratulations, reports and photos showing various phases of the project.
- 5. Information on financing the project should be included.
- 6. Include any information that demonstrates how the Lions Club, or lead club, may have involved or engaged with other members or organisations in the community and the benefit to the community.
